

To submit a paper for consideration for Best Paper Awards at ISIRC 2017 Conference, please note the following guidelines.

- 1 Manuscripts must be double-spaced throughout with generous margins. They should be sent in Microsoft Word format.
- 2 Papers should be carefully crafted and succinctly presented. The recommended length is between 5,000 and 8,000 words; papers must be fewer than 8,000 words. The word count includes tables, figures and references.
- 3 To permit anonymity, the authors' names should not appear in the manuscript. Instead, a cover page giving the title of the article and full identifying information (name, address, telephone and e-mail address) must be attached. The title of the manuscript should be on the first page of the paper along with the abstract and keywords. Language within the text that suggests the authors' identities should be avoided.
- 4 The cover page should be followed by an informative abstract of no more than 150 words. A list of 4–6 key words, in alphabetical order should be provided below the abstract.
- 5 Tables and figures should be incorporated into the paper. Each table and figure should be given a title.
- 6 Harvard is the preferred referencing style. However, any style may be adopted, provided it is used accurately and consistently throughout the manuscript and in reference listings.
